To Promote the Establishment of a Georgia Judicial Data Exchange Project for the State of Georgia

As Authorized by the Executive Board of the Georgia Association of Chiefs of Police

- Whereas;** A quality Georgia Judicial Exchange Program connects all of the aspects and participants in a judicial system; and
- Whereas;** Sharing comprehensive critical information in a real time format ensures timely dissemination to the appropriate decision makers in a judicial system; and
- Whereas;** This shared information breeds cooperation, and brings to a successful conclusion, cases that otherwise would linger for longer periods of time; and
- Whereas;** This data system holds all pertinent information in a case history format that can be utilized by all participants in the judicial system as a single point of contact for the case of interest without having to spend valuable time in the pursuit of what should be readily available information; and
- Whereas;** Being able to access complete case history information at the critical moment you need it results in significant time savings, eliminates redundancy, shows major improvements in the accuracy of information and produces a more efficient final end product; and
- Whereas;** All of these advantages result in a more efficient judicial system that protects the public and serves the interests justice in an effective and efficient manner; now therefore
- Be it Resolved;** That the Georgia Association of Chiefs of Police strongly recommends that a quality Georgia Judicial Data Exchange project be created and implemented in this Great State of Georgia.
